CALL MEETING TO ORDER

Committee Chair Safranski called the December 11, 2012 Engineering/Operational Committee Meeting to order at 7:02 A.M.

VISITOR PARTICIPATION

No comments were received.

ORAL COMMUNICATION

No comments were received.

COMMITTEE MEMBER COMMENTS

Committee Member Safranski commented on a letter he received from the Board of Directors of Mesa Water District.

REPORT FROM THE GENERAL MANAGER

The Acting General Manager, Mr. Ruiz commented on the following matters:

Mr. Ruiz commented that the Dove Center Property Management Company had notified the
District that there would be improvements made to the concrete paving at the entrance to the
shopping center over the course of the next few weeks. Discussion occurred concerning the
encroachment on the District's property and the Dove Center Property Management Company
management of the work.

2. Mr. Ruiz commented on the information discussed at the City of Rancho Santa Margarita's Pre-Construction Meeting for the Robinson Ranch Road Improvement/Traffic Calming Project. Discussion occurred concerning this project's proximity to the District's transmission line.

ITEM1: BAKER REGIONAL WATER TREATMENT FACILITY

The Acting General Manager, Mr. Hector Ruiz provided a status update on the project and commented that Irvine Ranch Water District (IRWD) is holding the next project meeting on Thursday to discuss and review the final project design. Discussion occurred concerning having a workshop to review the project and its final costs after the bids are received.

RECOMMENDED ACTION

ITEM 2: ALTERNATE RAW WATER TRANSMISSION LINE - PW79

The Acting General Manager, Mr. Hector Ruiz provided a status update on the project and commented that Tetra Tech has prepared sections of the project Environmental Assessment and is completing the funding analysis, per Federal Emergency Management Agency's (FEMA) format. Mr. Ruiz commented that staff is currently reviewing the funding analysis. Mr. Ruiz commented that when the final version of the funding analysis is submitted to FEMA, the District can expect a response approximately one to two months later. Mr. Ruiz commented that the Executive Summary of the funding analysis will be presented to the Board in the staff report. Discussion occurred concerning field surveying of the project site, and a description of the alternative transmission line options.

ITEM 3: SHADOW ROCK DETENTION BASIN FACILITY PROJECT

The Acting General Manager, Mr. Hector Ruiz provided a status update on the project and commented that the project is on schedule at this time. Mr. Ruiz commented that the project agreement has been reviewed by District Legal Counsel, and submitted to URS (Consultant). Discussion occurred concerning project notification to residents adjacent to the project site and coordination with the Trabuco Highlands Community Association.

ITEM 4: GOLF CLUB SEWER LIFT STATION UPGRADES AND REHABILITATION

The Acting General Manager, Mr. Hector Ruiz provided a status update on this project and commented that staff is waiting for the manufacturer tank drawings and specifications. Mr. Ruiz commented that the surge tank analysis is complete, and discussed the tank re-rating process to the Committee.

Discussion occurred concerning the possibility of purchase of a new surge tank for the sewer lift station.

RECOMMENDED ACTION

ITEM 5: EL TORO ROAD SEWER LIFT STATION AGREEMENT AMENDMENTS

The Acting General Manager, Mr. Hector Ruiz commented that there was no new or additional information concerning this matter at this time. Mr. Ruiz commented that Santa Margarita Water District (SMWD) is currently reviewing comments on the agreement.

RECOMMENDED ACTION

ITEM 6: DOVE CANYON MASTER ASSOCIATION (DCMA) LANDSCAPE STORAGE AREA

The Acting General Manager, Mr. Hector Ruiz provided a status update on this matter and commented that staff is in receipt and reviewing draft agreement language. Mr. Ruiz commented that he is reviewing available legal descriptions from the Dove Reservoir/Trabuco Highlands Reservoir Inter-Tie Project for possible incorporation in the proposed agreement, and that District Legal Counsel will review the final draft agreement prior to submittal. Discussion occurred concerning additional opportunities and scenarios for shared services with DCMA.

RECOMMENDED ACTION

ITEM 7: ON-GOING ENGINEERING PROJECTS

1. Dimension Water Treatment Plant Rehabilitation Project

Mr. Ruiz commented that the contractor ERS has signed the Agreement for Services, and that a Notice to Proceed letter is to be prepared for this project pending receipt of insurance certificates. Mr. Ruiz commented that a Pre-Construction Meeting date has been scheduled, and the project will require replacement of the cathodic protection for the filter tanks. Mr. Ruiz commented that more information will be presented at the January 2013 Committee Meeting.

2. Trabuco Dam Overlay

Mr. Ruiz commented that he is in receipt of a proposal for services from Genterra (Consultant), the engineers involved with the Dam's design. The Consultant's proposal included for the pavement repair and benchmark relocation at the Trabuco Dam (Dam). Mr. Ruiz commented that the relocation of the benchmark is required by the State. The pavement repair is primarily for preventative maintenance of the Dam's crest. Discussion occurred concerning the condition of the Dam; Director Mandich

requested that photos of the Dam's current condition be presented at the January 2013 Committee Meeting.

3. Other Projects

Mr. Ruiz advised there are no other projects to discuss at this time.

1. Saddle Crest Homes (65 DUs)

2. Skyridge Development (84 DUs)

Mr. Ruiz commented that there was a Public Hearing at the City of Mission Viejo City Hall the previous evening concerning this project.

3. Oaks at Trabuco (9 DUs)

Mr. Ruiz commented that there are no updates at this time.

4. Fieldstone (8 DUs)

Mr. Ruiz commented that there are no updates at this time.
